



## **Civilian Aides to the Secretary of the Army in the Sixth Region**

Civilian Aides provide individual advice to the Secretary of the Army, the Chief of Staff, Army, and commanders at all levels on public sentiments toward the Army. Civilian Aides work closely with all Army installations, commands, and other activities within their areas of responsibility. Civilian Aides support the Army through personal contact and correspondence with their colleagues, through public statements and appearances, and through participation in Army-sponsored events. Civilian Aides are provided timely, pertinent information on subjects of general interest about the Army, including topics and issues having particular application in their states. For protocol purposes Civilian Aides are ranked just below 3-star general officers and are considered to be the Secretary of the Army's personal representatives in their respective geographical areas.
