**ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION**

**All major Airlines Servethe Seattle/Tacoma area:** SeaTac (SEA) Airport is the closest to the hotel, 26 miles. Rental cars and shuttles are available.

**Driving Instructions:**

**From the North:** Follow I-5 S to E 27th St in Tacoma. Take exit 135 from I-5 S. Drive to E 27th St. Continue onto E 27th St (signs for Portland Ave). Use the right lane to stay on E 27th St. The hotel will be on the right.

**From the South:** Take I-5 N to E 28th St in Tacoma. Take exit 134 from I-5 N toward Portland. Follow E 28th St and Portland Ave E to E 27th St. Merge onto E 28th St. Turn left onto Portland Ave E. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto E 27th St. Use the right lane to stay on E 27th St. The hotel will be on the right.

**From the West:** Take I-90 W. Take exit 25 for WA-18 W toward Auburn/Tacoma. Use any lane to turn left onto Echo Glen Rd. Continue onto WA-18 W. Use the right 2 lanes to take the Interstate 5 S exit. Merge onto I-5 S. Take exit 135 for WA-167 N toward Puyallup/Portland Ave. Continue onto E 27th St (signs for Portland Ave). Use the right lane to stay on E 27th St. The hotel will be on the right.

## **Requirements for Entry to Joint Base Lewis-McChord**

All Military installations have been directed to begin enforcing the provisions of the REAL ID Act. This could present challenges for non-ID Cardholders who are guests at your event or function. **If you do not have the proper ID, please indicate that on your registration form so we can contact you for further information to get you access to JBLM.**

Below is a list of acceptable forms of ID:

- DoD Common Access Card (CAC).
- DoD Uniformed Services Identification and Privileges Cards.
- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card.
- VA Issued Health Card
- Permanent resident card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (INS Form I-551).
- Foreign passport with a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa.
- Foreign passport with a current arrival-departure record or foreign passport with INS Form I-94/I-94A bearing the same names as the passport and containing an endorsement of the alien's nonimmigrant status, if that status authorizes the alien to work for an employer.
- Employment authorization document that contains a photograph (INS Form I-766).
- US Refugee Travel Document I-327 and I-571 issued by DHS and containing a photograph
- Employee Identification Card issued by a federal, state or local government agency provided it contains a photograph and biometric information such as: Name, DOB, Gender, Height, Eye Color and/or Address.
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Transportation Worker ID Card (TWIC) issued by DHS
- Native American tribal document.
- U.S. Government issued, authenticated Federal PIV credentials.
- For personnel 17 and under, a school identification card with a photograph.
- US Military or Draft Record containing name and DOB.
- Washington State Enhanced Driver's License or ID Card
- Washington State Commercial Driver's License (CDL)

The 2017 Sixth Region Spring Meeting will be held on 20-22 April 2017, at the LaQuinta Inn in Tacoma, WA. The theme this year is in two parts: Soldier Readiness and Family Resilience. We will have the Adjutant General for the State of California, Major General **David Baldwin** as our speaker at the Saturday night dinner.

Thursday evening is our traditional Hospitality Mixer at the LaQuinta Inn. Come and enjoy the heavy appetizers, no-host bar, and the camaraderie.

Friday starts with breakfast, on your own, followed by a special tour starting at Joint Base Lewis-McChord. We will depart the hotel at 0800 and arrive at JBLM around 0900. There will be a tour of a Stryker and an active training at a range. The tour will be from 0900-1030 with an opportunity for questions/answers from Brigade Commanders. We will then head to the Port of Tacoma to take a special afternoon boat tour beginning at 1300 on one of the many Victoria Clipper boats. The ride will include a tour of the Puget Sound along with some beautiful views of the great Pacific Northwest. A boxed lunch will be served on board the Clipper. Menu choices will be made available prior to the event. We will arrive back at the hotel at approximately 1600. Dinner for the evening will be on your own.

Saturday also starts with breakfast, on your own, followed by our business meeting at the LaQuinta Inn. The day will include a panel discussion of experts from the Soldier Readiness arena and family support. A buffet lunch will be provided that day. Menu choices will be made available prior to the event.

The meeting is followed by the Annual Sixth Region Awards Banquet hosted at the LeMay Auto Museum. The evening will start with a Cocktail Hour from 1800-1900 and the banquet starting promptly at 1900.

The meeting is located in Tacoma and a mere 45 minutes from downtown Seattle. The trending area of downtown Tacoma is historic and buzzing and offers a wide variety of arts, culture, scenic views and amazing restaurants to choose from. All can be reached by taking a quick 10 minute Taxi or Uber ride from the hotel.
